## Frequently Asked Questions

The course codes are all different from Grade 10! What does the ' $M$ ' mean? Courses now have 'destination' based letters. ' $C$ ' for College, ' $U$ ' for University, ' $M$ ' for mixed ( $U$ and $C$ ), and ' $E$ ' for Workplace. Grade 10 applied courses will be prerequisites for ' $C$ ' and ' $M$ ' courses, and grade 10 academic courses will lead to ' $U$ '. For example: ENG2P-NBE3C, ENG2D-NBE3U, ENG2L-NBE3E.

So many Maths and Sciences! How do I choose? Science: you can choose from Biology, Chemistry, Physics, and Environmental, with varying destinations. Math and Science are offered $a t$, ' $C$ ', ' $U$ ', ' $M$ ' and ' $E$ '. Please be sure to refer to the Departmental flow charts in the Course Calendar.

How do I know what courses I need? Go onto myBlueprint.ca to see what courses you need for post-secondary programs in which you are interested.

## Can I repeat a course? Yes, you can take a course over, but IT DOES NOT COUNT AS ANOTHER CREDIT!

What is eLO? An online course, offered in Writer's Craft (EWC4U), Philosophy (HZT4U), Financial Accounting (BAT4M), Business Leadership (BOH4M) , World History (CHY4U), and Mathematics for College Technology (MCT4C).

I don't see the course I wanted to take. Why? Some courses are only offered every other year, such as Challenge and Change in Society (HSB4U), Nutrition and Health (HFA4U/C), Families in Canada (HHS4U/C), and Introduction to Kinesiology (PSK4U).

I want to do something different, have any suggestions? How about Cooperative Education, Environmental Studies (ESP), or Specialist High Skills Major? These are all great programs that offer a focus that might fit your interests.

How do I know what I have taken already? When you are in myBlueprint on the High School page, all your previous courses and marks earned are listed on your 'Official High School Plan'. If you look at the Graduation Indicator on the right side of the page, you can track your progress towards graduation, including number of compulsories and electives earned. You can also look at the page attached to your report card.

Can I choose courses online from home? Yes, you can start the selection at any point, even when the portal is closed. You can even make more than one plan depending on what your interests are. We will let you know when the online portal is open for submission in late February, and you can submit your final plan on a computer or on any digital device, including your cell phone, with your parents.

So, once I submit my choices I am done, right? Next year is all good to go? Unfortunately, it's not that simple. Sometimes courses are cancelled due to lack of interest or two courses you have requested run at the same time (that is where the alternates you provide are helpful). Therefore, please consider these selections as course requests, not a timetable. You also need to print and return a signed copy of your course selection sign-off sheet to the Guidance Department.

I still need help deciding! No Problem! Make an appointment with a counsellor preferably before course selection starts.
